French sailors first called the birds "le frégate" in the 18th century, after the small, fast frigate warships of the era. The Royal Navy referred to them as "Man-o-war" birds. There are five species of frigate birds found around the world. The largest of these is the one seen throughout the tropical waters of Florida and throughout the Caribbean — the Magnificent Frigate.

Seeing an opportunity to maximize the advantages, while innovating solutions to the drawbacks of a performance catamaran, Invincible teamed up with Gino Morrelli and Pete Melvin of Morrelli & Melvin, the designers behind some of the most iconic sailing catamarans of the past 20 years: PlayStation/Cheyenne, America's Cup Winners, BMW Oracle USA and Aotearoa Team New Zealand.
